## University of Missouri - St. Louis IT Enterprises Building Mechanical Upgrades

In October 2011, Haberberger, Inc. was selected by Volk Construction Company to perform the HVAC mechanical upgrades at the University of Missouri - St. Louis' IT Enterprises Building. This project includes the installation of new chillers, boilers, energy recovery equipment and a new laboratory exhaust system. Under the direction of **Scott Loehr** with Volk Construction, our field team, led by **Doug Coonrod** and **Mike Bene**, is working hard toward a substantial completion in early March 2012.

## University of Missouri - Columbia Combined Heat and Power Upgrade

Haberberger, Inc. recently started a piping project at the University of Missouri - Columbia power plant. Haberberger is responsible for ancillary piping, HVAC and plumbing. The HVAC and plumbing are being performed by subcontractor H.G. Butzer. The University has contracted separately for installation of a new biomass-fired fluidized bed boiler, which handles bituminous coal and wood chips as fuel. All work will be completed in the spring of 2012.

## VA John Cochran Replace Medical Gas Systems

Haberberger, Inc. has been contracted by Guarantee Interiors to replace the medical gas system at the VA John Cochran Medical Center. Project Manager **Mike Conway** and General Foreman **Tom Masterson** face the challenge of performing the work while existing systems are in operation.

## Lemay UV Disinfection

WWTP U.V. disinfection facility. Haberberger will perform equipment setting and piping work for the general contractor, KCI. This process treats final effluent from the plant with ultraviolet light. Haberberger project manager will be Jeff Roberts.
